Laws Whiskey House is a grain-to-glass distillery in Denver, Colorado that applies a "there are no shortcuts" philosophy to each batch of whiskey produced. Each batch is milled, cooked, fermented, distilled, and aged on-site, utilizing heirloom grains from family-owned Colorado farms. The practice of open air, on-grain fermentation captures the essence of Colorado's terroir while the copper pot-column still produces a robust, grain-forward style of whiskey.

With our fellow whiskey hunters in mind, we selected this individual barrel of Four Grain Bourbon to be bottled at Cask Strength due to its noteworthy character and concentrated flavors. The respective influence of our heirloom grains, heavily charred 53-gallon white oak barrels, and microclimates of the San Luis Valley and Eastern Plains of Colorado are elegantly articulated in this single barrel of our Four Grain.

- Aromas and flavors vary from barrel to barrel
- Mash Bill: 60% corn, 20% heirloom wheat, 10% heirloom rye, 10% heirloom malted barley
- Aged over three years in new, 53 gal, charred oak barrels and bottled at cask strength
