Laws Whiskey House is a grain-to-glass distillery in Denver, Colorado that applies a “there are no shortcuts” philosophy to each batch of whiskey produced. Each batch is milled, cooked, fermented, distilled, and aged on-site, utilizing heirloom grains from family-owned Colorado farms. The practice of open air, on-grain fermentation captures the essence of Colorado’s terroir while the copper pot-column still produces a robust, grain-forward style of whiskey.

The novel character of our Four Grain Bourbon would not exist without the terroir-driven flavors imparted by the heirloom wheat, rye, and malted barley grown by our friends at the Cody family farm. Fittingly, each year the Codys come over from the San Luis Valley to sample their way through our aged Four Grain Bourbon, selecting the single barrel they believe best celebrates the soul of their unadulterated grains and singular Colorado terroir.

- ◆ Tasting notes vary from barrel to barrel, though the farmers tend to select single barrels that showcase the sweet grassy notes of their white centennial wheat with a smooth, easy-drinking finish.
- ◆ Mash Bill: 60% corn, 20% heirloom wheat, 10% heirloom rye, 10% heirloom malted barley
- ◆ Aged over three years in new, 53 gal, charred oak barrels
