Laws Whiskey House is reimagining great American whiskey by creating unique and bold flavor experiences. Our grain-forward style whiskeys are made with the highest quality heritage and heirloom corn, wheat, barley, and rye grown by two Colorado family farms. We use time-tested production techniques that showcase each individual grain's terroir resulting in singular and novel whiskeys.

This release comes from just eight barrels, each aged 10 years and 10 months, making it some of the oldest rye we've ever bottled. What makes these barrels even more special? They were distilled using our original rye mash bill: 95% rye and 5% malted barley. This whiskey was crafted before we transitioned to our 100% rye mash bill, making it a true snapshot of our early distilling days. This is a rare look back at where our rye program began, preserved for over a decade and bottled exactly as the Bottled in Bond Act intended.

- ◆ Tasting Notes: Toasted rye bread with honey or maple, candied orange, and black tea. Dark chocolate and even a hint of coffee in a lingering finish. Balanced and medium-full bodied.
- ◆ Mash Bill: 95% heirloom rye, 5% heirloom barley
- ◆ Aged over 10 years in new, 53 gal, charred oak barrels
- ◆ First Bottled in Bond rye whiskey in Colorado history

Meets the standards of the **Bottled in Bond Act of 1897**. Bottled in Bond requires that the whiskey be a product of a single season, using the grain of a single season, made by one distiller at a single distillery, and aged at least four years in a federal government-bonded warehouse. The whiskey is then cut and bottled at 100 proof (50% ABV).
