Laws Whiskey House is reimagining great American whiskey by creating unique and bold flavor experiences. Our grain-forward style whiskeys are made with the highest quality heritage and heirloom corn, wheat, barley, and rye grown by two Colorado family farms. We use time-tested production techniques that showcase each individual grain's terroir resulting in singular and novel whiskeys.

This bourbon is the result of a unique collaboration between distillers, beekeepers, and honey bees. First, we make our small batch Four Grain Straight Bourbon using new charred oak barrels. After harvesting the bourbon, a local apiary fills our barrels with their delicious honey which interacts with the remaining bourbon and char while also coating the inside of the barrel. After harvesting the honey, the apiary then sends the barrels back to us to refill with Four Grain Straight Bourbon for a second round of aging. The added sweetness accentuates the notes of black tea, orange blossom, and cinnamon. We hope you enjoy this full circle collaboration and cheers to our local pollinators for all their hard work.
