ABOUT THIS WHISKEY

- The topo map on this release's label was created by Kind Design and depicts a section of the Colorado River through Ruby Horsethief
 Canyon on the Western Slope of the state 39.1722° N, 108.9565° W.
- We proofed this whiskey with purified water from the Rocky Mountainfed headwaters of the Colorado River, collected outside of Rocky Mountain National Park, to create an entirely novel bourbon that celebrates this limited release's namesake.
- Mash Bill: 60% corn, 20% heirloom wheat, 10% heirloom rye, and 10% heirloom malted barley
- ◆ Aged: 4 7 years in new 53 gal, charred oak barrels
